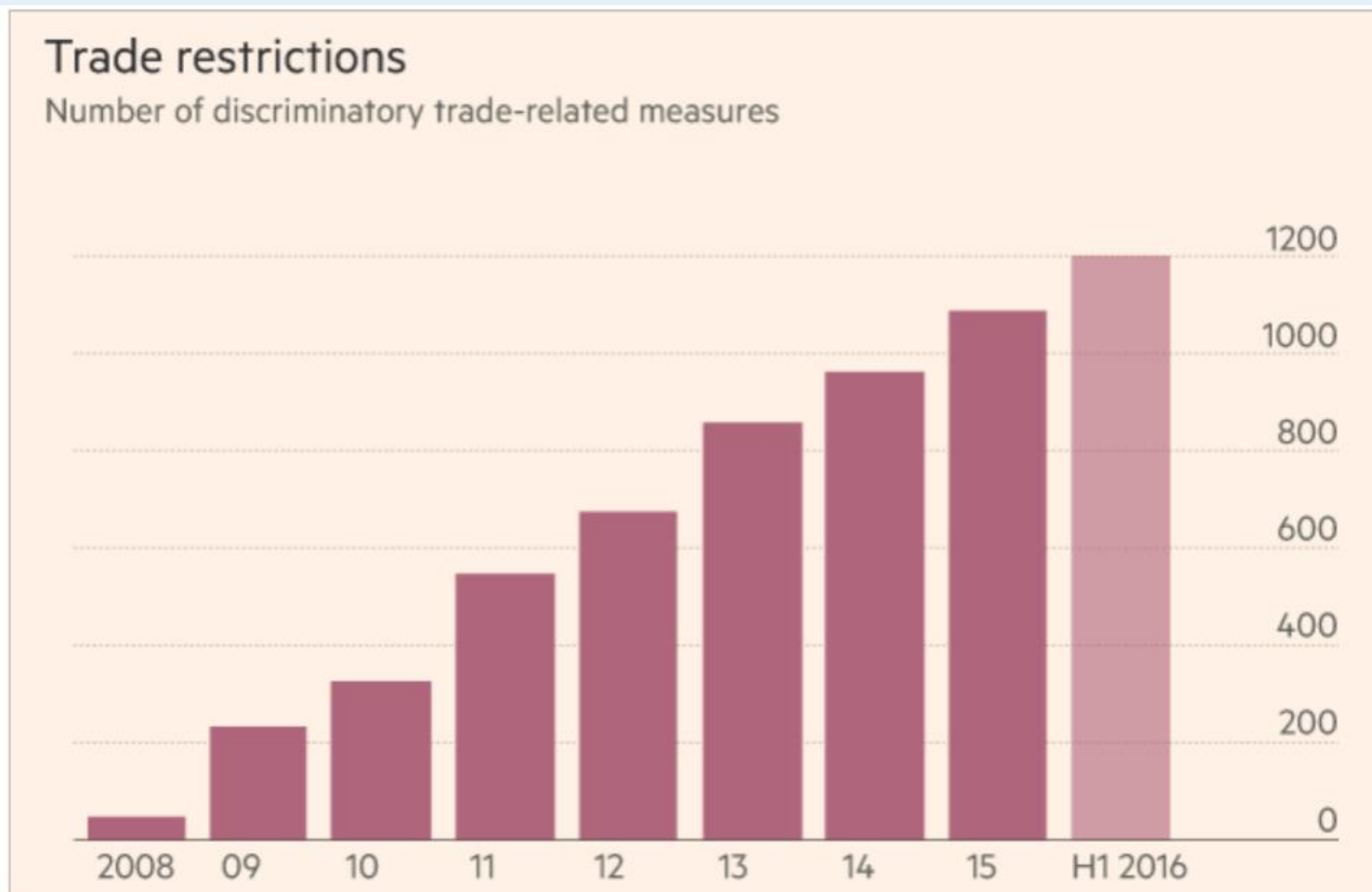

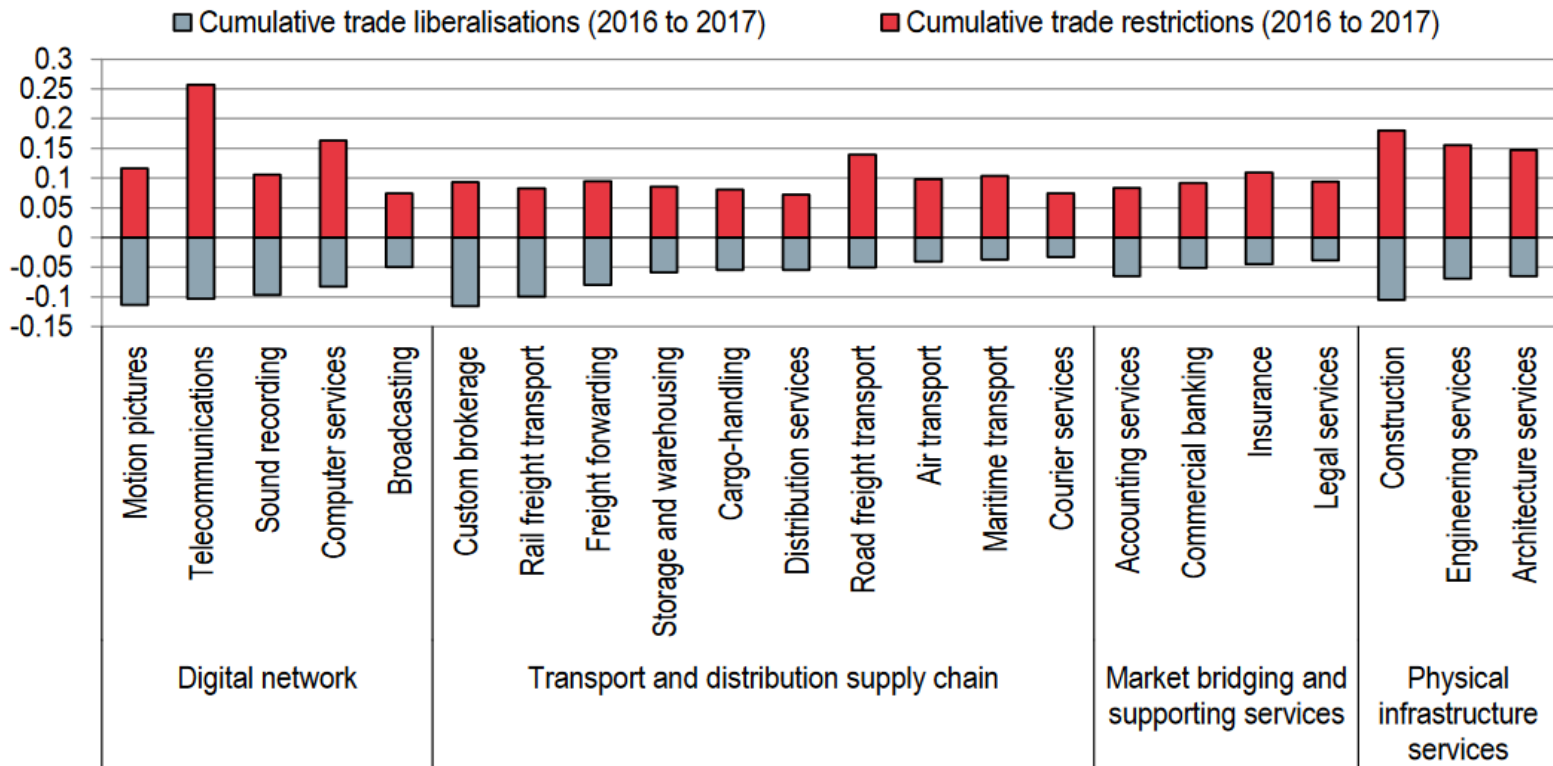
Protectionism leads to trade restrictions
